Targets

Targets are developed using the Absolute Contraction Approach (ACA), ensuring alignment with a 1.5°C pathway and formulated according to the requirements of the Science Based Target Initiative.

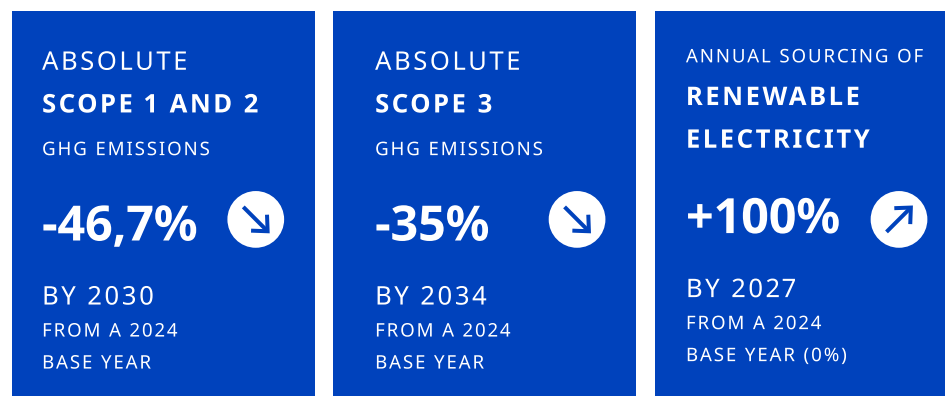
Scope 1: Direct emissions (operational control)

Scope 2: Indirect emissions from purchased electricity (market-based & location-based)

Scope 3: Purchased Goods & Services (most material category)

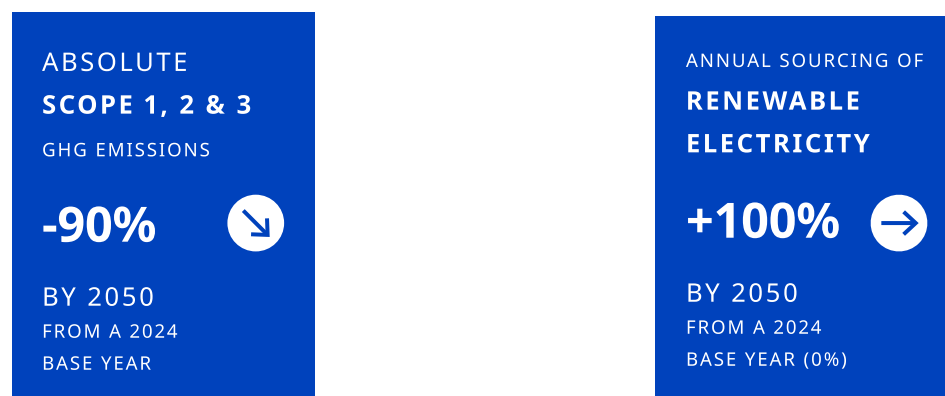
Near-term targets

Net Zero

Umios Food Europe commits to achieve net-zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050.

Emissions Inventory Context

The SBTi-assessment identified Scope 3 Category 1 (Purchased Goods and Services) as the dominant emissions source.

This category alone represents the vast majority of total Scope 3 emissions and is therefore included in the target boundary, ensuring compliance with SBTi requirements to cover at least **67% of Scope 3 emissions**, and in line with the Green House Gas (GHG) Protocol.

Other categories were assessed and excluded where deemed immaterial based on their relative contribution.

Progress Reporting

Progress will be tracked as absolute emissions reduction (tCO₂e) and the percentage reduction achieved versus baseline

In addition, Umios Food Europe will monitor year-on-year emissions trends to ensure alignment with the target trajectory and ensure consistency and comparability of emissions data over time.

Implementation

Our decarbonization strategy focuses on key operational and value chain drivers:



Energy sourcing

Transition to 100% renewable electricity by 2027



Logistics optimization

Reduction of emissions linked to transportation and distribution through efficiency improvements



Supplier engagement

Active collaboration with suppliers to improve data quality and reduce emissions associated with purchased goods and services

Actions are based on existing initiatives and data-driven priorities, without reliance on unverified assumptions.

Governance

Responsibility for climate targets is embedded at management level, ensuring oversight and accountability.

Sustainability considerations are increasingly integrated into: procurement decisions, supplier engagement processes and sourcing strategies.
